How many beds are there in the standard hotel rooms?

Room options include a single room with one single bed, a double room for sharing with one double bed, or a twin room for sharing with two single beds.

Can I bring my child to the retreat?

Where possible, we encourage sisters to attend the retreat without their children, so they can fully immerse themselves in the experience. However, we understand this may not be feasible for everyone. For those who need to bring their children, we are happy to consider this on a case-by-case basis, subject to availability. Limited crèche facilities are available and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that there is a charge for using the crèche. I need to cancel my room as I am now unable to attend, what shall I do?

Any cancellations must be confirmed via email to salam@quranhalaqah.com and will be subject to the following charges:

- 90% of the full retreat price if cancellation is made within 4 weeks prior to the start date of the retreat
- 70% of the full retreat price if cancellation is made between 5 – 6 weeks prior to the start date of the retreat
- 50% of the full fee is payable if cancelled between 7 – 8 weeks prior to the date of the retreat

Alternatively, it is possible to transfer your booking for the retreat to someone else's name, however please note that we are unable to refund you and then sell it to the new person. Any payments will need to be dealt with between the other person and yourself. After you have transferred your place, please inform us of the updated details via email (at salam@quranhalaqah.com) not

Please note that booking changes are only permitted up to a maximum of 7 days before the event. With a limited number of spaces for our retreat we expect in shaa Allaah to have more than enough sisters willing to attend should you need to cancel your place.
